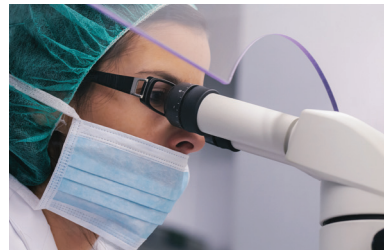
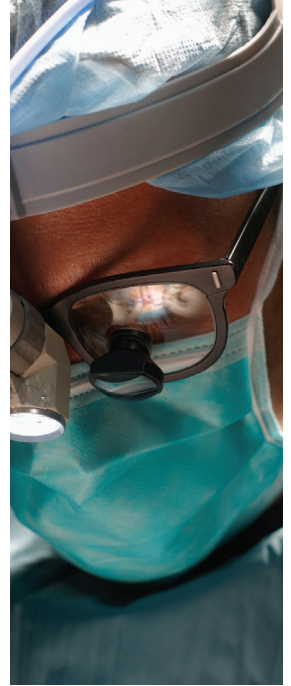
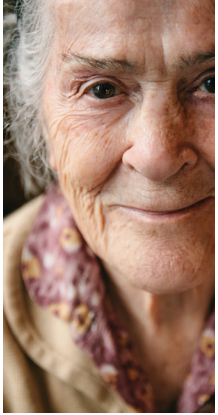


LAWSON HEALTH RESEARCH INSTITUTE

For more than thirty years, Lawson Health Research Institute in partnership with Western University has been driving innovation and helping transform health care. As one of the ten largest hospital-based institutes in Canada, we have grown our research funds by 33 percent over the last six years.

Within the Institute, a “bench to bedside” approach to medical research is encouraged.
