The Research Assistant position is based in the Prevention and Early Intervention Program for Psychoses (PEPP) at London Health Sciences Centre and Lawson Health Research Institute. The successful candidate will be working on research within PEPP and projects related to global mental health initiatives.

The Research Assistant will be responsible for aspects of data collection, including interviewing clients, database development and management, data entry and verification, literature searches, and other tasks related to research projects and maintenance of a large database, and would provide assistance with preparation of ethics submissions, grant applications and manuscripts.
